Hornberger Worstel designed these cylinder wall mounts to look like they were part of the original building. Built in 1964, this award winning chapel was designed by Reed & Tarics. The non-denominational church is part of the Roberts Louis Stevenson School located on the famous 17 mile drive on the Monterey Peninsula. The fixtures combine high output CF lamps and a PAR 20 downlight. The pine needle pattern was silk screened by a graphics firm as it was too fine in detail for laser cutting.
